

## *Hear To Serve....*

GO? I JUST GOT HERE.

Do you think this is what some of Jesus's disciples thought? How long had they really been with Jesus? After just a short time of listening and learning, Jesus started sending them out two by two to go and preach and heal in His name. They must have been surprised to be sent so soon. I know that's how many of us feel at the end of Mass every Sunday. "What? It's over already? I just got here."

Well, if you didn't realize it, today's Gospel from Mark has a very crucial element that is continued on today in the Mass. That is Jesus's dismissal, Jesus's words that sent the disciples to go out and preach and heal in His name.

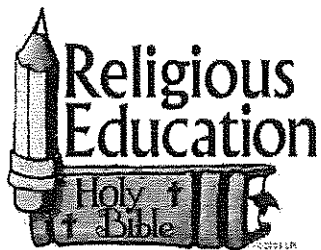
Jesus sent the disciples out with very little to their names. They could take with them a walking stick, a pair of sandals and their tunic. They could take no food, no sack, and no money. The disciples had to count on people's kindness to be fed. Try that at your favorite restaurant after Mass today.

The word Mass actually means, "To be sent out." The word Mass is derived from the Latin words, "Ite Missa Est." This means, "Go, it is the dismissal." So, is it more correct to say, we go from Mass, instead of saying we go to Mass?

Jesus instructed the disciples to travel light, to be focused on the mission and not on possessions, power, and wealth. The Mass is not a bunch of activities to keep us busy for an hour. The Mass is not a bunch of rituals to make us look holy. The whole Mass is part of Jesus's commissioning of the original twelve. We are given what we need for our mission. We do not need power, money or possessions to carry out Jesus's mission. We are baptized, we are nourished by the Word of God, and we are fed the Body and Blood of Christ. These are the things we need to be Disciples of Christ. We are then sent out to go and preach the Gospel of the Lord. We are sent out to visit the sick. We are sent out to bring compassion, generosity, and mercy to all that we meet. It is by doing these things that we make the Mass holy and authentic for all.

So, the next time you are at Mass don't be too eager to go out to do Jesus's work. Stick around and listen for the words; listen for the commissioning handed down from Christ himself. "The Mass is ended. Go in peace, and glorify the Lord by your life."

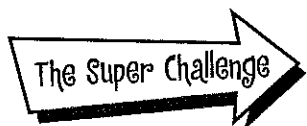
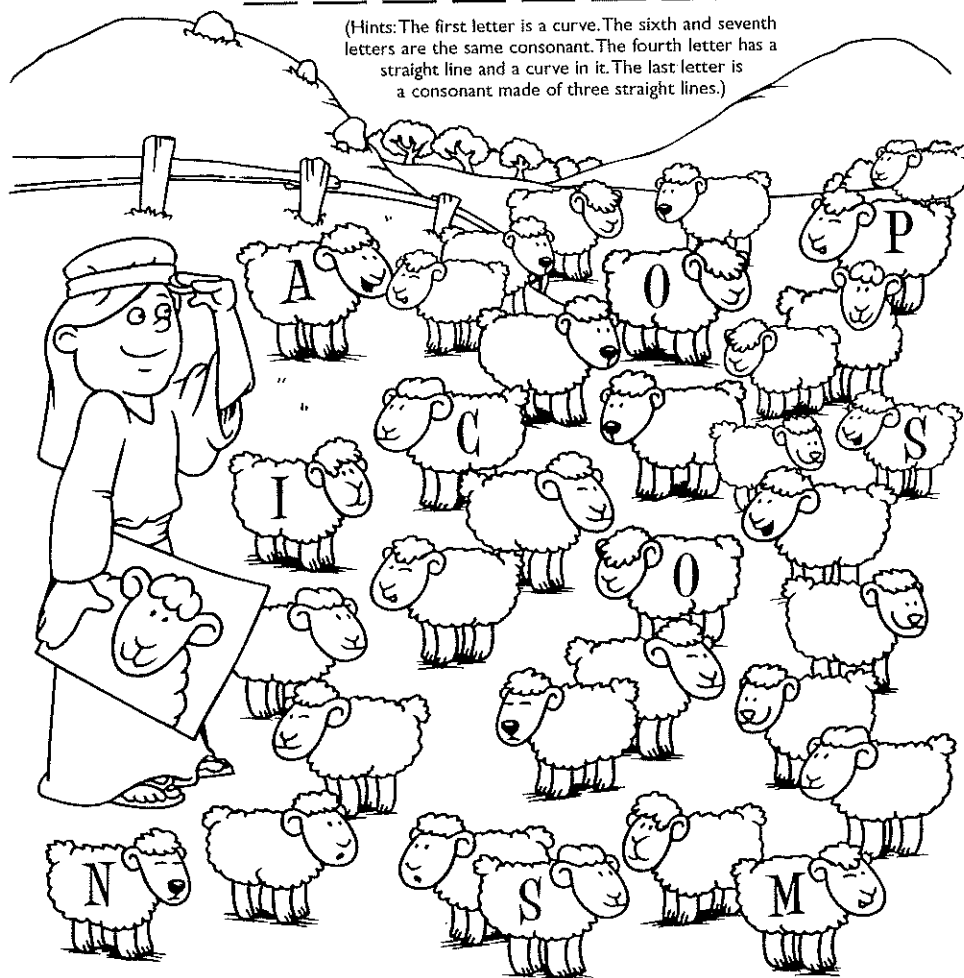
# LOST AND FOUND
