Thoughts for Today's Readings

To the Point: The text "John 3:16" shows up on everything from T-shirts to signs at sporting events, so much so that even if we know the content of the verse, we can forget the context. Nicodemus, a Pharisee, is curious about Jesus and meets him at night. The two share a conversation around flesh and spirit, light and darkness, eternal life and condemnation. It is in the context of relationship and mutual desire to know the other that Jesus shares his own essential nature – the one sent by the Father so that we might have life in the Spirit. God does not wish to remain hidden. Instead, God wants to enter into relationship with us and to reveal God's self to us – in prayer, through the sacraments, through the tradition of the church, and through a special way in the Scriptures, the inspired word of God. Whenever we approach God in earnestness, God will be there with us as himself: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

To Experience: Coming to know "one God in three persons" is more than solving the math problem $1+1+1=1$. Belief in a triune God is to know that the very essence of God's inner life is relationship – that the outpouring of love between the Father and Son is so great that it becomes its own person, the Holy Spirit. Our own relationships share in the relational nature of God whenever we imitate this self-giving love.

1. In the incarnation of Jesus and his life among us, we see all that it means to be God in human form. How have you come to know God through Jesus?
2. The essence of our trinitarian God is loving relationship. Where have you been able to recognize God's presence in your own relationships? In which relationships is God's love most difficult to recognize?

Walking with the Trinity

The feast of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to look beyond a complex theological mystery and focus on the deeply personal relationship God wants to share with us in the world.

In the First Reading from the Book of Exodus, Moses encounters the Lord on Mount Sinai. Upon hearing the Lord proclaim His name as a merciful, gracious, and patient God, Moses immediately offers a beautiful prayer: *"If I find favor with you, O Lord, do come along in our company"*.

This heartfelt plea is exactly what we need for our own lives. We must constantly seek to find the favor of God and deliberately invite Him to come along with us on our daily spiritual journey. We do not walk this road alone; the Triune God desires to be our constant companion.

Living in the company of the Trinity naturally transforms how we treat one another. In the Second Reading, St. Paul gives us a clear roadmap for community life: *"Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace"*. When we intentionally choose unity over division, St. Paul promises that the God of love and peace will be with us.

Finally, our Gospel seals this divine promise of love. We are reminded of the ultimate hope of our faith: everyone who believes in Jesus might not perish but might have eternal life. God didn't send His Son to condemn us, but to save us.

This week, let us open our hearts to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Let us ask the Lord to "come along in our company," mending our relationships and trusting in the eternal life promised through Christ.

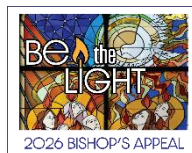
