Thoughts for Today's Readings

To the Point: Continuing through Matthew's Gospel, Jesus gives instructions to the Twelve as they prepare to begin ministry – in particular, to avoid fear in proclaiming the gospel. Immediately before today's passage, Jesus warns the apostles about the inevitability of persecution for their preaching. In spite of this, however, Jesus reassures them that the Father will care for them and protect them. Jesus uses two images to make this point. If God knows the whereabouts of a sparrow and the number of hairs on a person's head, then the apostles can trust that God would care even more for them. Jesus also reminds them what is truly important – the soul, rather than the body. While the body passes away, the soul is eternal. Assuring them in the face of persecution, all those who wish to do them harm can only reach the body – no one can harm their souls except themselves, if they were to deny Jesus.

To Experience: Even though most Christians in the developed world do not face the same persecution experienced by the early church, there are still many cultural challenges that make the Christian life difficult – consumerism, secularism, nationalism, and individualism, to name just a few. While these bigger trends can make our own call seem impossible, thinking locally and personally can help make this task feel more manageable. Each of us is called to bring the gospel into our own relationships in both words and actions, trusting in God's support as we witness to his love for us.

Live in the Light

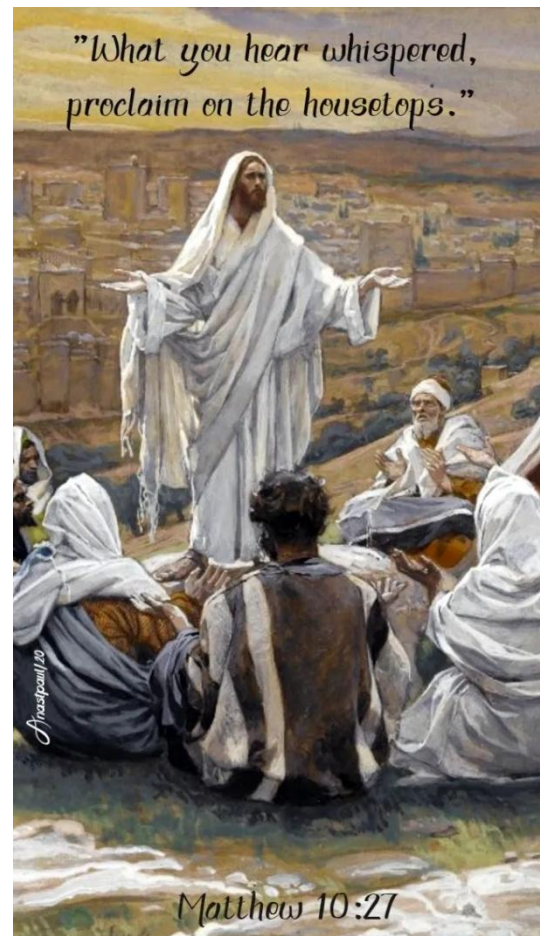
Dear Friends, If we look closely at our daily lives, it is easy to find things that make us feel anxious. We often worry about what others think of us. We might even feel afraid to talk about our faith, worrying that we will be judged or left out.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus looks directly at us and says: "Do not be afraid," and "Fear no one." Jesus reminds us that God cares for us down to the smallest detail. He tells us that God even knows the number of hairs on our heads. When we truly understand how deeply we are loved by God, our fear of the world starts to melt away. You do not need to worry about the opinions of others because you are already safely held in God's hands.

Jesus does not want us to keep His love to ourselves. He gives us a clear mission. He says: *"What you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops."*

In the ancient world, the roof of a house was the loudest place to make a major announcement. Jesus is telling us that our faith is not a well-kept secret. It is not something we should hide away inside the walls of this church. The love and hope we find in prayer are meant to be shared openly. If God's mercy has touched your heart, you are called to bring that light out into the open for everyone to see.

This week, let us step out of the shadows of fear. Be brave, be kind, and let your life be a megaphone for God's love.

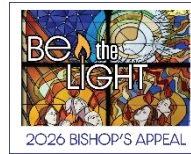
