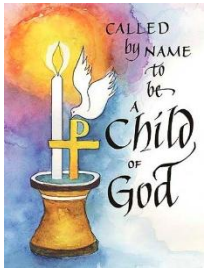

Thoughts for Today's Readings

To the Point: Jesus' teaching to the Twelve has extended over the past couple Sundays, and today's instruction might be the most difficult yet.

Not only are disciples challenged to endure persecution, but also to put their family second to their mission. The "good news" does not always feel good. With this harsh warning, Jesus introduces one of the great paradoxes of the Christian life: in self-emptying love, we find ourselves. The initial example Jesus gives for the apostles is hospitality. The person who receives another receives Christ himself. The likely intention of the phrase "little ones" is to refer to the disciples still growing in faith, but this can be extrapolated in our imagining to include all those in need of "a cup of cold water" – the poor, the vulnerable, the marginalized. This passage also points forward to Matthew's account of the Last Judgement in chapter 25: "Whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me." Again, hospitality is the criterion on which the follower of Jesus will be held to account.

To Experience: On the one hand, Jesus promises that his "yoke is easy" but on the other, Jesus hands on some teachings that are incredibly difficult to accept and to follow. Jesus asks us all to take up our cross and follow, lest we be declared unworthy of him, choosing to leave our family behind if necessary. Thankfully, for most of us, following Jesus means leaning into our family relationships and loving them as Christ, but this call to prioritize Jesus also cannot leave our minds entirely. What does it look like for you to love Christ above all else?

1. Jesus tells the apostles that they must love him more than anything or anyone else. Is there anything that you would struggle to place Jesus ahead of? Where is Jesus inviting you to follow him more fully?

Radical Love and Total Allegiance

At first glance, the gospel teaching of this Sunday can feel harsh. Is Jesus telling us to reject our families? Absolutely not. Rather, He is using dramatic, intentional language to challenge our ultimate priorities and re-orient our hearts.

What Does It Mean to Be "Not Worthy"?

To be "worthy" of Christ does not mean earning His love through our own perfection or merits. Salvation is always a free, unmerited gift of grace. Instead, being "worthy" in this context speaks to our alignment, readiness, and total commitment to follow Him.

Jesus is shedding light on three essential truths of discipleship:

- **Christ Must Be Center Stage:** Our love for Jesus must be the foundational compass that guides every other relationship. When we place Him first, our love for our spouses, children, and parents is actually elevated and purified, falling into its proper, beautiful order.
- **No Half-Hearted Alliances:** Jesus does not want part-time followers who treat faith as one optional item on a busy to-do list. He demands our ultimate loyalty.
- **The Measure of the Cross:** True discipleship is expressed in our willingness to accept the daily sacrifices required to walk in His footsteps.

Jesus concludes with a powerful paradox: *"Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."* Holding tightly to our own plans, comfort, and egos ultimately leaves us spiritually empty. It is only when we empty ourselves and surrender our lives entirely to God that we find the true, lasting joy and freedom we were created for.

This week, let us ask ourselves honestly: What attachments am I holding onto that keep me from full communion with Christ?

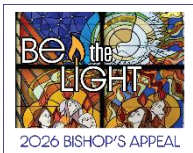
